Work Hours: 7:00 – 5:30 (Monday through Thursday)

Job Description: Installs machinery and equipment according to layout plans, blueprints and other drawings in industrial establishment using hoists, lift trucks, hand tools and power tools.

Responsibilities:

- Reads blueprints and schematic drawings to determine work procedure.
- Dismantles machines using hammers, wrenches, crowbars and other hand tools.
- Move machinery and equipment using hoists, dollies, rollers and trucks.
- Assembles and installs equipment using hand tools and power tools.
- Constructs foundation for machines using hand tools and building materials such as wood, cement and steel.
- Aligns machines and equipment using hoists, jacks, hand tools, squares, rucs, micrometers and plumb bobs.
- Assembles machines and bolts, welds, rivets or otherwise fastens them to foundation or other structures using hand tools and power tools.
- May operate lathe to grind, file, and turn machine parts to dimensional specifications.
- May repair and lubricate machines and equipment.
- May perform installation and maintenance work as part of team of skilled trades workers.
